1 A call to use public transportation

Summer 2012

- Trial offer for motorists (with registration, valid for 5 consecutive days)

Fall 2012

- One month free with purchase of first annual subscription to public transportation at regular price

2013

- Annual public transportation subscription for 2013 at the 2012 annual subscription price offered to present holders of an annual pass

2 Addition of 33 km of lanes reserved for public transportation

Fall 2012

- Configuration of reserved lanes on De la Concorde Blvd in Laval (eastbound)
- Configuration of reserved lanes on Pie-IX Blvd in Laval, between Saint-Martin Blvd and the Pie-IX Bridge (southbound)
- Configuration of reserved lanes on Pie-IX Blvd in Montreal, between Jarry and Charlevoix Streets (northbound)
- Configuration of reserved lanes on Henri-Bourassa Blvd in Montreal, between Saint-Michel and Lacordaire Boulevards (both directions)
- Configuration of reserved lanes on Léger Blvd in Montreal (westbound), between Lacordaire and Henri-Bourassa Boulevards
- Configuration of a reserved lane on Route 132 in Boucherville, between De Montarville Blvd and the Highway 25 / Highway 20 / Route 132 Interchange (westbound)
- Extension of Marc-Cantin Street in Montreal and configuration of reserved lanes (both directions)

2013

- Configuration of reserved lanes on Highway 40 in Montreal between Saint-Charles and Cavendish Boulevards (both directions)

3 Improved access to the metro and commuter train network

Fall 2012

- Increase in the number of buses that can be at the Radisson station at the same time
- Improvement in the access to the Saint-Hubert station

4 Addition of more than 3,600 places per day to the bus networks and 3,600 places each rush hour in the metro

Already in service

- Additional service on Société de transport de Laval's lines 144 and 151 (Pie-IX construction site)

Summer 2012

- Additional service on the metro's yellow line (construction vacation weeks)

Fall 2012

- New service on the Pie-IX axis between Laval and Montreal (Pie-IX metro)
- Additional service on Société de transport de Laval's lines 904, 925, 52 and 252 (Pie-IX construction site)

5 Addition of 819 parking spaces to commuter train stations

Fall 2012

- Addition of approximately 200 spaces to the Vimont station
- Addition of approximately 100 spaces to the Pointe-Claire station
- Addition of approximately 200 spaces to the Saint-Constant station
- Addition of 319 spaces and 6 bus spaces at the Candiac station

6 Addition of 785 parking spaces at bus stations

Fall 2012

- Configuration of 185 spaces and 5 bus spaces in Chateaugay
- Almost 100 existing spaces made available to public transportation users in the De la Concorde Blvd axis in Laval
- Configuration of a temporary parking lot with approximately 400 spaces on Saint-Martin Blvd in Laval
- Addition of 100 spaces and 5 bus spaces in Chambly

7 Improvement in access to stations and metro stations for cyclists
