# What is a village-relais?

A village-relais is a municipality with a population of less than 10,000 accredited by the gouvernement du Québec and located along recognized provincial highways and tourist routes.

The villages-relais are always committed to honour a quality charter that guarantees essential services and minimum business. hours, as well as nice, safe, welcoming places to stop.

You can stop there to rest, eat and fill up the gas tank, among other things.

There is a network of about forty villagesrelais in Québec. You will encounter them at average intervals of 80 kilometres, approximately once per hour of driving time.

# Safe stopping places

Making a stop in a village-relais is a good way to counter the effects of driving fatigue and driver distraction, reducing the risk of accident.

### Tourist attractions and a welcoming environment

In addition to services, the villages-relais offer cultural and natural tourist attractions, quality developments and a welcoming environment.
